One of Austin’s most prestigious residential developments, the Cat Mountain Homeowners Association (CMHOA) was established in 1987. Currently, it consists of 355 lots and 26 acres of common area in the wooded hills of Northwest Austin along Mt. Bonnell Road north of RM 2222. The CMHOA includes several member-only facilities, including a clubhouse, swimming pool, tennis courts, and hiking trails. The CMHOA consists of homes ranging from the mid \$200s to over \$1,000,000 with the median price hovering around \$450,000.
